

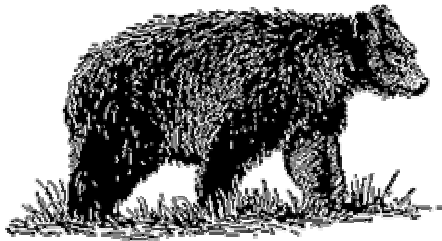
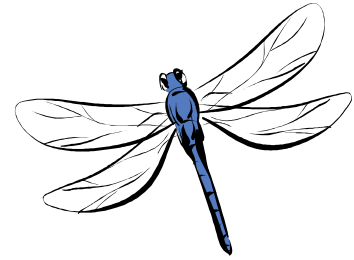
Free Children's Programs in the Parks

Black Bears

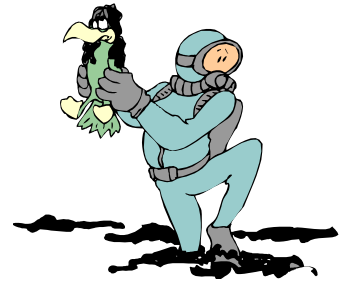
Do you have what it takes to be a back bear? Eat their food, find a home, and protect your cubs?
